Smile allot today and count how many people smile back.

Offer to help in wrapping presents.

Make hot chocolate as a family and enjoy it together!

Make some Christmas cookies/cakes
(Don't eat them all we will need some for tomorrows Advent task).

Take some Christmas cookies/cakes to a sick or elderly friend.

Hug everyone in your family today!

Draw or colour in a picture of the 3 wise men following the star.

Help Mummy with the washing up.

Go to the Candle Lit Christmas Eve Service

Put a birthday candle on your Christmas cake and sing happy birthday to Jesus and blow the candle out!

Instructions

Get your child to fold in the two outside columns so that they partly cover the words.

Turn your pages over and get your child to decorate the blank side of the pages with glitter or pretty swirly crayon patterns. Then turn back over, unfold the columns and cut along the width ways lines. Stick your first loop together ensuring that the words are on the inside. When making loop number 2 make sure it is threaded through the first loop. Repeat until the chain is completed.

On Dec 1st let you child rip off the first loop (number 1 loop) at the point where you stuck it together then the little message on the inside will be fully visible for you to read out and all enjoy!
