Welcome to the Little Treasures Parent and Toddler Group, where we aim to provide a safe, caring and stimulating environment for you and your child/ren.

Who are we?

Little Treasures is part of Mow Cop Community Church. Ruth Winterton is the main co-ordinator. Other Little Treasures helpers are experienced parents who are committed to everything the group stands for.

Sessions:

Term time only!
Every Friday 10am -12 midday.



We (as we are sure you do at home) encourage respect for toys and the belongings of others - please assist your child/ren in helping to care for our toys, and tidy them away at 'tidy up time'. Please respect our church building.

Charges: We charge £1.00 per family per week.

Little treasures is a non-profit making venture. All money collected is used to replace used and broken toys, to provide suitable art and craft materials, and of course refreshments.

Little Treasure's funds are subsidised by the church who do not charge for the use of the hall and it's facilities. The church wishes you to feel valued and supported, as such any information about church or special events that may be of interest will be passed on with the assurances that you would be made most welcome. Little Treasures is run by Christians and stands for Christian principles.

Activities:

Every session has a different theme. Below is a rough session format:



Free Play
Story Time
Activity Time - *exploring the session's theme*
Crafts and Free Play
Refreshments - *for both parent & child!*
Free Play
Tidy up Time

Singing & Action Rhymes - *to help children wind down ready for home!*



We do realise that some of the art & craft materials in the craft area may be unsuitable for the **very young child**. Please be extra vigilant and supervise your child accordingly.

Refreshment Time/Story Time/Singing Time:

To help Little Treasures run smoothly and be the best it can for your child and yourself, we ask that at both refreshment time and story time you encourage your child to participate in the group setting. Even babies can benefit from these interactive group settings and as such we encourage the babies to sit with the group at refreshment time and also join with the rest of the children for the story time and singing time. Children learn most instinctively through mimicking and so we would ask that during the story and singing time parents resist the urge to talk amongst themselves and instead join in with the children.

Illness:



To promote the very best safety for parents, children and volunteers at Little Treasures we do ask that if your child is unwell, has a bad cold or any flu symptoms, or has had diarrhoea/vomiting within 24 hrs that you do not bring them to Little Treasures.

Supervision and Discipline:

Your child is YOUR responsibility, children **MUST** be SUPERVISED by an adult at all times. We expect you to monitor your child's behaviour during the session. Your attendance at Little Treasures' sessions is an acceptance/agreement of the information laid out in this leaflet.

Above all we wish your child/ren to have fun in a loving Christian environment!! Children learn essential social skills and grow in confidence in the company of other children. We aim for your little one to grow up as a true 'Little Treasure' !!!
